Finals Aspirations-

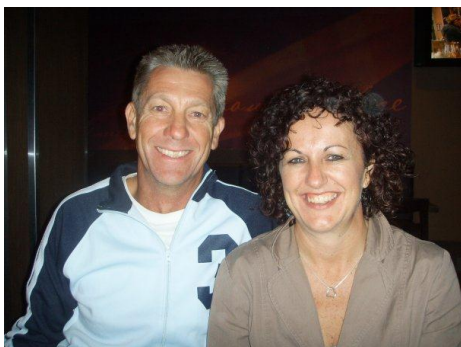

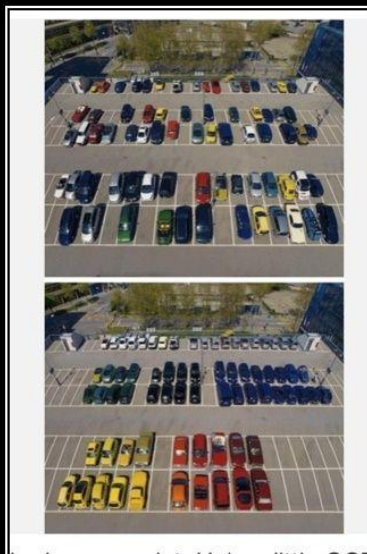
